AWARDS

- Class: Credits awarded in each class/judge. 1st -2 credits; 2nd thru 6th - 1 credit each. Credits may be redeemed for \$1.00 or a ribbon. Credits will be tabulated in the office and awarded at check out. (Anyone Can Ride classes will not receive any credits due to the reduced fee.)
- Hi Point & Reserve Hi Point award APHA Walk/Trot Youth & Amateur: One Horse/One Rider. Must compete in a minimum of three (3) Walk/Trot classes. Only Walk/Trot classes to count (no other classes will count for this award).
- Hi Point & Reserve Hi Point award Novice Youth: One Horse/One Rider. Must compete in a minimum of three (3) Novice Youth classes.
- Hi Point & Reserve Hi Point award Youth 13 & Under: One Horse/One Rider. Must compete in a minimum of three (3) Youth performance classes. Halter will count but not mandatory.
- Hi Point & Reserve Hi Point award Youth 14 – 18: One Horse/One Rider. Must compete in a minimum of three (3) Youth performance classes. Halter will count but not mandatory.
- Hi Point & Reserve Hi Point award Green Handler/Rider: One Horse/One Rider. Must compete in a minimum of three (3) Green Handler/Rider classes.
- Hi Point & Reserve Hi Point award Novice Amateur: One Horse/One Rider. Must compete in a minimum of three (3) Novice Amateur classes.
- Hi Point & Reserve Hi Point award Amateur 19 - 44: One Horse/One Rider. Must compete in a minimum of three (3) Amateur performance classes. Halter to count but not mandatory.
- Hi Point & Reserve Hi Point award Amateur 45 & Over: One Horse/One Rider. Must compete in a minimum of three (3) Amateur performance classes. Halter to count but not mandatory.
- Hi Point & Reserve Hi Point award Amateur Solid Paint Bred: One Horse/One Rider. Must compete in a minimum of three (3) Amateur Solid Paint Bred performance classes. Halter to count but not mandatory.
- Hi Point & Reserve Hi Point award Solid Paint Bred: One Horse/One Rider. Must compete in a minimum of three (3) Solid Paint Bred performance classes. Halter to count but not mandatory.
- Hi Point & Reserve Hi Point award Green Horse: Must compete in a minimum of three Green Horse classes. No other classes will count.
- Hi Point & Reserve Hi Point award Jr Horse: Must compete in a minimum of three (3) Open performance classes. Halter to count but not mandatory.
- Hi Point & Reserve Hi Point award Sr Horse: Must compete in a minimum of three (3) Open performance classes. Halter to count but not mandatory.
- In the event of ties, the placings of exhibitors involved in the tie will be used to determine winner. If necessary due to tie of placings, Judge A as listed in premium will be tie-breaker judge.
