If you're able please try to bring a side dish to add to the food. Drinks will be provided by Sarival Ranch Equine.

Camping space is available for living quarters horse trailers or you can pitch a tent. There is no electric hook ups or water hookups. Water will be available for your horses in a water trough but there is no running water.

There are no pens for stalling at the Ranch. You will have to picket line to your trailer or bring your own portable pens.

The trail ride on Saturday will begin at 11 a.m. The trail options are endless but will be guided by Carolyn herself along the General Crook Trail. The trail ride on Sunday will begin at 10 a.m. and again will be guided by Carolyn. These trails can range from sandy washes to rocky & hilly. Be sure your horse is appropriately shod and/or booted up for the terrain. If on the off chance we have storms that weekend the ride may be canceled. Please make sure I have a good phone number to contact you! Please make sure you are dressed for the right weather as well as your horse.
